In 2010 she founded the Center for Diagnosis and Functional Rehabilitation for Children with Visual Impairment or Multiple Disabilities at the Civil Hospital of Brescia (ASST Spedali Civili, Italy).

She's author of 236 papers published by indexed Journals, 8374 citations; H Index 43 (Scopus).

The main clinical fields of interest are: neurology of newborn; follow-up of preterm infants, rare neurological diseases (particularly Aicardi Goutieres syndrome), cerebral visual impairment of central and peripheral origins, neurodevelopment and neurodevelopmental disorders, cerebral palsy, neurorehabilitation and early intervention.

Since November 2021 she is the President of the Italian Society of Child and Adolscence Neuropsychiatry (SINPIA) and she's the past president of the Société Européenne de Neurologie Pédiatrique (SENP) which she lead as President from January 2018 to December 2020.
